Dakota Rogaining Championships

Come navigate the Black Hills of South Dakota

On May 8 and 9, the inaugural Dakota Rogaining Championships will be held in Custer State Park. With course design by Rick Emerson (of Primal Quest Badlands 2009 fame), these Champs promise to provide challenges to test the best and scenery to drool over.

The Rogaines will include a 24-hour championship (USOF sanctioning applied), a 12-hour intermediate race, and a 4-hour short course for beginners and juniors. Teams may consist of two to five members and USOF rules of competition apply. Start times will be staggered so all participants finish Sunday midday.

An awards ceremony and barbeque will follow to acknowledge all participants and recognize class winners. Teams are divided into categories of Men, Women, and Mixed. Within each category, there are divisions by age - Junior, Open, Veteran, and Superveteran.

Class - Male, Female, or Co-ed

Age Group - Open, Veteran (all members 40+), Super-Veteran (all 55+), or Junior (one adult for safety, all others under 18)

12-Hour or 24-Hour fee is \$80 - add \$5 more for registration after April 18.

4-Hour participant fee is \$50 - add \$5 more for registration after April 18.

Event long sleeve performance tee is available at an additional \$25.
