Semi-Annual Land Navigation Class October 25 & 27

Master the use of topographic map and compass to travel through the wilderness with skill and confidence. This class is an evening in-town session then a full day in the field at a site near the town of Superior. It is designed for adults and is a very intensive, hands-on program.

Participants meet **Thursday**, **October 25th** (6-9 PM) in the metro Phoenix area for a classroom session then **Saturday**, **October 27th** (7 AM until dark) near the town of Superior for a field session. Primitive car camping is available Friday night at the field site.

Students will walk four to five miles, with day packs, learning and practicing land navigation methods and techniques. The course covers compass use, interpreting topographical maps, and six methods of getting from point to point (walking a straight line, using checklines, contour lines, and catch features, honing in and funneling). You will also learn aiming off, pace counting, triangulation, and more. We provide dinner at the classroom session, plus breakfast, lunch, snacks and dinner at the field session. Students must provide their own transportation to and from the site.

Students provide their own Silva Ranger 15 CL 360degree compass. (Another model may be used if it has a baseplate, a mirrored lid with a site and a mechanical declination scale adjustment). A Silva compass may be rented for \$5.

Cost is \$100 (fully refundable until 10/19/2007). Members who have joined prior to Aug 1, 2007 get a \$20 discount.

Class alumni, if it's been awhile since you've been practicing, you may take the class again for half price (\$50.00). Ask any of our previous students and they'll tell you what a great class it is.
