April 13: Saguaro Lake 3-Hour Score-O

Please join us on **Sunday April 13**, **northeast of Phoenix**, north of Saguaro Lake, for a **three-hour Score-O**.

The terrain is rolling hills with patches of rocky ground on mostly open grassland. The majority affords clear running, but watch for loose rock and the occasional cactus. There will be two water stations on the course and water will be available at the timer's table.

The three hour Score-O will have about 25 controls scattered throughout the area. The course opens at 9:00. There is a 3-hour time limit for the Score-O, The penalty for being over the 3-hour limit is10 points per minute. Anyone not off the course and checked into the timer's table by 1:30 pm will be scored a DNF (Did Not Finish).

A **free beginner's clinic** will be held at 9:00 to go over compass skills and map reading basics. It's really worth the time to attend the clinic.

Participants under age 18:

All participants under age 18 are now required to have a signed parental consent form on file with the club. You can complete the form (available on the gphxo.org website) before the event and either scan it and send it to us by e-mail or bring it with you to the event.

Directions to the Event:

Beeline Highway: From the Loop 202 head northeast on Country Club Road (in Mesa), which turns into the Beeline Highway (87). Continue on the Beeline Highway 22 miles (past Fountain Hills) to the Saguaro Lake/ Bush Highway turnoff. Turn right and follow the Bush Highway 0.2 miles to the event site on the right side of the road. Look for the orange and white orienteering signs marking the pull off to the parking area.

Bush Highway: From Power Road and the Superstition Freeway (US60), go north 22 miles (Power Road turns into the Bush Highway). You'll pass the Usery Pass junction in 13.5 miles, but continue heading north on the Bush Highway. When you see the sign that says "Junction 87 - 1/2 mile", look for the orange and white orienteering "sandwich boards" marking the parking area on the left.

What to Bring

- water bottles & water. There will be water at the start/finish, and two water stations out on the course.
- whistle required, can purchase for \$1
- compass can rent for \$1

- sunscreen no shade on the course
- sturdy hiking shoes and long pants

Note on Registration:

Since this event is not at a City of Phoenix site, you will not need to register through their site. Just show up and sign in at the registration table!
