Aug. 9-10: Lake Mary Night-O and Score-O

Saturday and Sunday, **August 9-10**, we are pleased to present a weekend of Orienteering activities in the Flagstaff Area.

Please note that there was an adventure race scheduled for August 9th - this event has been CANCELLED.

Sat evening, August 9 Lake Mary Night-O

Escape the summer heat for the cool pines up north. After a short break, we're at it again on the Lake Mary course south of Flagstaff hosted by a new Event Director / Course Setting team. The team is working hard to put on a quality event that is worth the trip.

On Saturday, August 9th, we'll be offering a Night-O under the full moon. The course will be a Score-O with 10-15 controls in ~4-5 km. Everyone will have two hours to find as many controls as they can. Mass start at 8pm.

Sun a.m., Aug 10 - Lake Mary Score-O

Sunday, August 10th, will be another Score-O event

with 25+ controls over a 5 sq. km. course. This event will have a three hour time limit, with the **course closing at 1 pm**. There will also be a "Beginner's Clinic" available as part of the Sunday morning event.

Event site coordinates for mapping apps: 35.0700410522, -111.601091255

From Phoenix, take I-17 northbound; just before the I -40 junction in Flagstaff take exit 339, Lake Mary Road. From Flagstaff, make your way to Lake Mary Road via Beulah Boulevard/Hwy 89A.

Once on Lake Mary Road, head southeast ~5.5 miles to FS 132 (S. Crimson Rd). Turn right at FS 132 and go south ~3.3 miles to the 132/132D intersection. Bear right at the Y to stay on FS 132. Continue ~.75 miles on FS 132 to FS 9419W.

The event site is located ~100 meters down FS 9419W. Park anywhere along 9419W. There will be signage to direct you to the event site/parking area. Be sure to look for orange O-signs at starting at the Lake Mary turn off and along FS 132. See camping notes on page 3 of this newsletter.
