

Greater Phoenix Orienteering Club - Getting There is ALL the Fun!

Saturday January 10 - Robbins Butte

Join us on SATURDAY, January 10th at Robbins Butte (southwest of Phoenix) where we will have four "Classic" orienteering courses available. "Classic" orienteering courses mean that the participant must visit the control points in the prescribed order printed on the map. There will also be a beginner's clinic and an instructional course for teaching the fundamentals of orienteering.

Robbins Butte is near the Buckeye Hills recreation area in the west Valley. The terrain is a mixture of rocky outcroppings and flat desert. Due to the relatively flat terrain and sparse vegetation, crosscountry travel is "friendlier" than on some of our other maps--there are very few areas of dense cactus or catclaw. On most parts of the map, terrain visibility is also excellent.

Multiple Control Format

In fact, the terrain is so open that your course setter is bringing back the multiple control format (or as he calls it, the "Uh-O"). For the open area on the east side of the map, several controls of similar features can--and will--be placed as close as 50 meters to the control that you are looking for. In other words, there will be 60+ controls out there, but only a subset will

appear on your map and control card. So don't necessarily dart for the first control marker you see, and be especially careful to check the control code to make sure it matches you control card before you punch-and-run.

People of all skill levels are encouraged to participate. A free beginners' clinic will be available for new participants and those needing a refresher

We still need volunteers to help with equipment setup, registration and timing tables, and with bag pick-up after the meet. Contact Glenn Haselfeld (glennoutdoor@cableone.net) if you can help.

Participants under age 18:

All participants under age 18 are now required to have a signed parental consent form on file with the club. You can complete the form (available on the gphxo.org website) before the event and either scan it and send it to us by e-mail or bring it with you to the event.

What to Bring

- water bottles & water. There is one water stop on the Orange, Red and Green courses, but there is no water on the Sprint or Teaching courses.
- whistle required, can purchase for \$1
- compass can rent for \$1
- sunscreen little or no shade on the course
- sturdy hiking shoes and long pants

Map Notes

The base map has not been updated for a few years, and vegetation mapping is still incomplete. Regions that have had the vegetation mapped are enclosed by a dashed green "vegetation boundary" symbol. Individual trees are marked as follows: a smaller green dot denotes a "mature saguaro", defined as having at least one vertical arm of at least 1-m in height. The saguaro uses the "coniferous" symbol as the feature description on the control card. A larger green dot denotes a (non-cactus) tree that is 5-m or more in height. Trees use the "deciduous" symbol as the feature description on the control card.

Directions

From Phoenix, go west on Interstate-10 to exit 112, then south on AZ Highway 85 for ~7 miles to milepost 147. Take a right at the sign for Robbins Butte Wildlife Area. Proceed ~3.8 miles on dirt road (bearing left at the sign "Powers Butte Wildlife Area & access to Robbins Butte (Mountain)") to the Start Area. The road is passable to passenger cars.

From Tucson, take Interstate-8 West from Casa Grande to Gila Bend. Take AZ Highway 85 north for ~27 miles and turn left at the sign for Robbins Butte Wildlife Area (a left turn lane just before milepost 147--before you cross the Gila River). Proceed ~3.8 miles on dirt road (bearing left at the sign "Powers Butte Wildlife Area & access to Robbins Butte (Mountain)") to the Start Area. The road is passable to passenger cars.
