March 14-15: Black Canyon City

Please join the Greater Phoenix Orienteering Club as we present a weekend of navigation fun at a new location for the club. We start the weekend at the High Desert Park in Black Canyon City (off I--17 north of Phoenix. Sunday's events take place in the rugged terrain of the Black Canyon surrounding the Agua Fria River.

Saturday, March 14, Saturday's events include a beginner's clinic, a beginner's practice course, and two shorter "sprint" orienteering events.

High Desert Park, part of the Yavapai County Park System, contains a nice taste of rolling hills and desert washes at the south end of Black Canyon City. This area provides a chance to experience a thicker covering of desert vegetation than is available at lower altitudes. We strongly recommended you wear sturdy pants for the events. You'll experience a higher concentration of prickly plants in the area.

Sunday March 15, we'll continue the fun by offering a **2-Hour Score-O** and a **5-Hour Adventure Race**. Sunday's events start in the gravel parking area just north of the Rock Springs Café, also close by I-17 exit 242.

Notes

In the beginner's clinic, we'll introduce participants to concepts of navigation using only a map and compass. We'll then apply the concepts to navigate a course on an orient-eering map. The Clinic is open to participants of all ages and at all levels of skill and fitness.

Directions

Travel on Interstate 17 to exit 242 (Rock Springs). Travel west 0.1 miles to the Old Black Canyon Highway. Travel south 0.2 miles to the parking area just north of Rock Springs Café on the west side of the road.

Cost

Score-O registration fee is \$5/10 individual, \$8/15 team (separate from Saturday's event). The Adventure Race fee is \$20 per person.

Notes

During a Score-O, participants take up to a designated time limit to search for controls indicated on a pre-printed orienteering map. Controls are assigned different point values based on the distance they are located from the starting point and on the navigation difficulty. Participants are not required to follow a set course but instead try to maximize their point total through their own route choice.
