# Saturday 11/12, Beginner's Training

The Greater Phoenix Orienteering Club will present a FREE class on basic navigation concepts used in orienteering. The class is in one of the meeting rooms at the Mesquite Library (near Paradise Valley Mall). Participants will learn techniques involved in navigating with topographic maps and a compass. Navigation techniques used in orienteering are invaluable for times when GPS receivers are unusable. The class runs from 9 to 10:30 am. Preregistration is requested (not required) for this event

If you have a compass, please bring it; we will have some loaner compasses available if you don't have one.

#### Saturday 11/19, Lake Pleasant Score-O

Join us for a 3-hour Score-O just west of Lake Pleasant on the Carefree Highway (west of I-17). The goal is to find as many controls as you can in any order. Points are assigned to each control based on difficulty and distance away from start.

# What to Bring (Score-0):

- Whistle (Mandatory for all. Available for purchase at Phoenix events for \$1)
- Compass (Mandatory for all. Available for rent at Phoenix events for \$1)
- Water. There will be water at the start/finish.
- Sun screen.

Sturdy hiking shoes and long pants are recommended. You may encounter cactus, cat claw, and loose terrain.

# Directions to Mesquite Library:

The Mesquite Library is located just north of Paradise Valley Mall, near the intersection of Cactus Road and Tatum.

- Exit State Route 51 at Cactus Rd. (exit 10)
- Travel east on Cactus for 1.2 miles
- Turn left (north) and go 0.5 miles on North Paradise Village Parkway. Library is on south side.

#### **Directions to Lake Pleasant:**

- Take the Carefree Highway exit from I-17 and travel west 13.2 miles to Christian Church Camp Road (there is no sign for this road!) Look for an orange and white Orienteering sign marking the turn. The road is 0.6 miles west of milepost 18, about 1.5 miles west of the main Lake Pleasant entrance.
- Travel north 0.7 miles to the event site located on the east side of the road.
