Sat/Sun 2/11-12 - Clinic, Night-O & Score-O

We have another big weekend coming up—a Beginner's Clinic near Paradise Valley Mall, a Night-O event at Needle Vista and a Score-O at First Water (both sites NE of Apache Junction).

Saturday 2/11, Beginner's Clinic

From 9-10:30 am on Saturday, GPHXO presents a FREE Beginner's Orienteering Class, including a short practice course, at the Mesquite Library near Paradise Valley Mall. Learn the basics of navigating with a topographic map and compass (for when that new GPS breaks down!)

Saturday 2/11, Night-O

Arrive between 6:30 and 7:15 pm to experience nighttime orienteering. Find as many controls as you can—in the dark! In addition to the usual "what to bring" items—bring a flashlight or headlamp, spare batteries and a spare flashlight!

Sunday 2/12, Three Hour Score-O

On Sunday, the course will be open from 8 am— 1pm. We will have about 25 controls. We'll have a free clinic for Beginners at 8 am

Pre-registration

For all three events, we request that you pre-register if you are planning to attend. It really helps us know

how many maps to print and other details. Preregistration for all events is via google docs, with links on the front page of our website at gphxo.org.

Costs:

The Beginner's Clinic at Mesquite Library is free.

For the Night-O and Score-O events:

What to Bring:

- Whistle (Mandatory for all. Available for purchase at Phoenix events for \$1)
- Compass (Mandatory for all. Available for rent at Phoenix events for \$1)
- Water. There will be water at the start/finish.
- Sun screen.
- For the Night-O event, be sure to bring a flashlight or headlamp—and a spare light, and extra batteries.

Sturdy hiking shoes and long pants are recommended. You may encounter cactus, cat claw, and loose terrain.

The Mesquite Library (Saturday morning) is at 4525 Paradise Village Parkway North, Phoenix, AZ 85032 on the north side of Paradise Valley Mall.

The Needle Vista site (Saturday Night-O) is about 7 miles northeast of Apache Junction on Hwy 88. We will meet in the parking lot at the Needle Vista turnoff.

The First Water Site (Sunday Score-O) is about 5 miles northeast of Apache Junction, again, on Hwy 88. Turn right on FR 78, the First Water Trailhead Road; we will meet up near the horse staging area.

Recent Event Results


January 7, Robbins Butte Score-O
