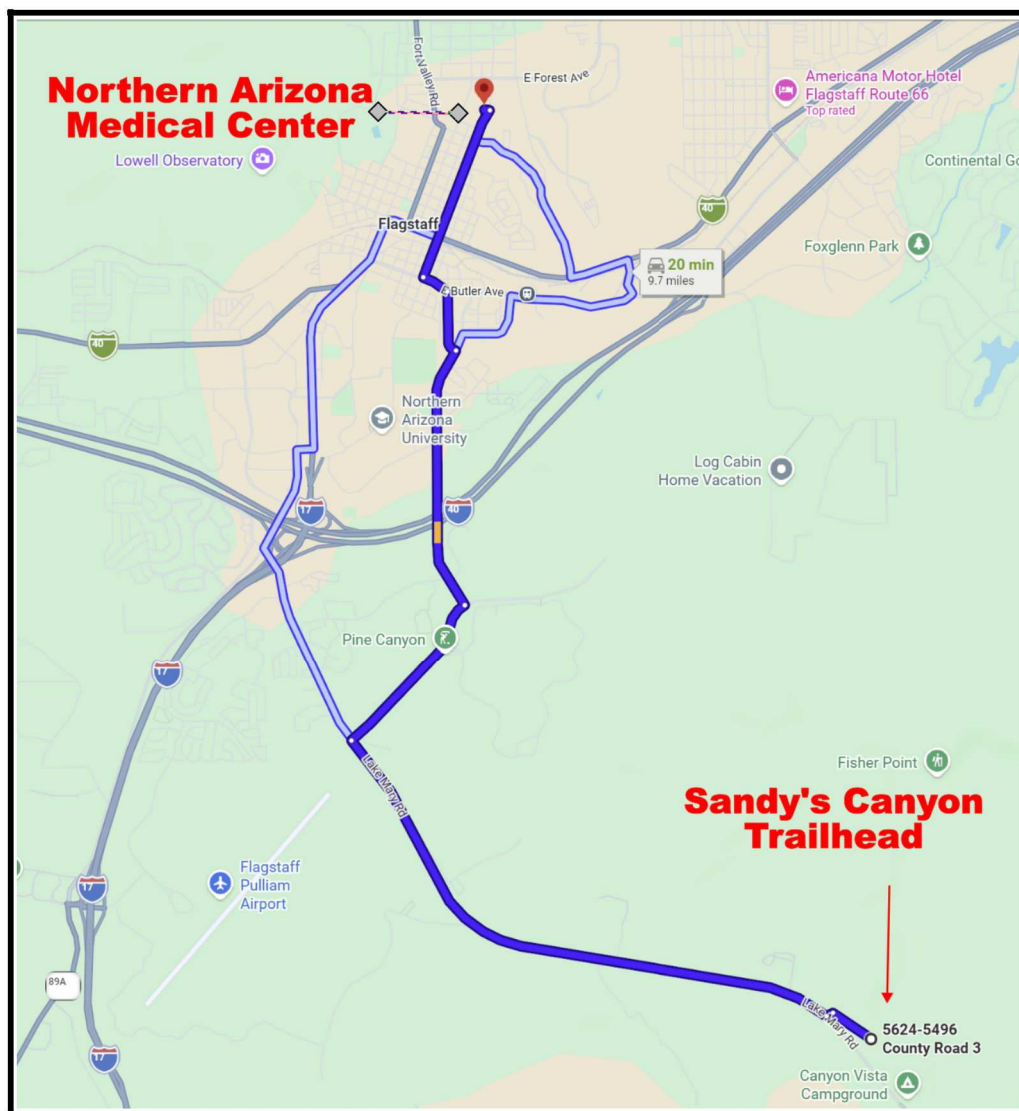


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Attachment 1 Map to Local Emergency Hospital - Overview Map
