Saguaro Lake Night-O (Saturday December 8) Score-O (Sunday, December 9)

The Greater Phoenix Orienteering Club is hosting two days of orienteering fun the weekend of December 8th and 9th in the Tonto National Forest just north-east of the Phoenix metropolitan area. On Saturday, we'll conduct a two-hour Night-O, an event where everyone puts on headlamps and tromps around the desert for up to two hours in the dark. On Sunday, we'll more than double your fun by offering a three-hour Score-O. Further details for both events are found below. We hope you'll consider joining us for a great weekend of navigation fun.

NIGHT-O, SATURDAY 12/8/12

On **Saturday, December 8th**, the Greater Phoenix Orienteering Club will host a **Night-O** near Saguaro Lake. Sunset will be at 5:20pm and there will be a quarter moon. The course will open at 6:30pm once it gets good and dark. Bring a flashlight! Participants will have 2 hours to locate as many control markers as possible to accumulate points. Controls will be worth points based on level of difficulty and distance. Participants may choose to compete for time or complete the course recreationally (time not recorded).

SCORE-O, SUNDAY 12/9/12

Join us **Sunday, December 9th**, near Saguaro Lake for a nice, long **Score-O**. This type of orienteering means participants will have 3 hours to locate as many control markers as possible to accumulate points. Controls will be worth points based on level of difficulty and distance. Participants may choose to compete for time or complete the course recreationally (time not recorded).

The terrain is rolling hills with patches of rocky ground on mostly open grassland. The majority affords clear running, but watch for loose rock and the occasional cactus. There will be one Water station on the course and water will be available at the timer's table.

People of all skill levels are encouraged to participate. A free beginner's clinic will be available for new participants and those needing a refresher. You may start anytime after the course opens at 6:30pm until 7:30pm (8:30 am to 11am for the Score-O). Everyone, competitors and recreational participants alike, must be off the course and checked into the timer's table by 9:30 pm when the course closes (2:00 pm for the Score-O).

What to bring:

Flashlight! (for Night-O)
Water bottle(s), food.
Whistle (required for all: available for \$1)
Compass (available to rent for \$1)
Sunscreen, hat, sturdy shoes, long pants

Directions for Both Events

The directions for both the Night-O on Saturday, December 8 and the Score-O on Sunday, December 9 are the same. For both events, there are two routes to get to our Saguaro Lake event site: the Beeline Highway (87) and the Bush Highway.

For the Beeline Highway (87) coming from the south:

From the Loop 202 head northeast on Country Club Road, which turns into the Beeline Highway. Continue on the Beeline Highway 22 miles (past Fountain Hills) to the Saguaro Lake/Bush Highway turnoff. Turn right and follow the Bush Highway 0.2 miles to the event site on the right side of the road. Look for the orange and white orienteering signs with glowing chem lights marking the pull off to the parking area.

For the Beeline Highway (87) coming from the north:

For those coming from the north, a better route to reach the Beeline Highway could include traveling east on the Loop 101 to Shea Boulevard, then continuing east on Shea until it intersects the Beeline Highway at Fountain Hills. Once on the Beeline Highway heading north, you continue approximately 10 miles to the Saguaro Lake/Bush Highway turnoff.

For the Bush Highway coming from the south:

From Power Road and the Superstition Freeway (US60), go north 22 miles (Power Road turns into the Bush Highway). You'll pass the Usery Pass junction in 13.5 miles, but continue heading north on the Bush Highway. When you see the sign that says "Junction 87 - 1/2 mile", look for the orange and white orienteering "sandwich boards" with glowing chem lights marking the parking area on the left.
