Sat. Sept. 10: Lowell Observatory (Flagstaff)

We're excited to offer a new event site for you to practice your navigation skills. In partnership with the Flagstaff Extreme Adventure Course, we're hosting two orienteering events on Saturday, August 27 at the Fort Tuthill County Park just south of Flagstaff.

Beginner's Clinic

We'll use this clinic to teach basic navigation concepts that will help you navigate through any of our orienteering events. These same concepts are equally useful for any land navigation using a compass and topographic maps. .

Two Sprint Events

A "sprint" event is a shorter orienteering event that typically includes less-difficult control locations. The sprint event is designed for quick navigation choices as opposed to more complex navigation found in longer events. Sprint events are excellent for both beginners and seasoned orienteers alike.

Pre-registration is recommended. While on-site, dayof-event registration is available, we will print a limited number of extra maps. We cannot guarantee that we'll have maps for everyone who registers on the day of the event. We strongly suggest that you pre-register to ensure you get a map. To pre-register, go to the event page:

What to Bring (all events):

- Whistle (Mandatory for all. Available for purchase at Phoenix events for \$1)
- Compass (Mandatory for all. Available for rent at Phoenix events for \$1)
- Water. There will be water at the start/finish.
- Sun screen.

Sturdy hiking shoes and long pants are recommended. You may encounter cactus, cat claw, and loose terrain.

Directions to Lowell Observatory:

From the Flagstaff area:

- Travel to the intersection of South Milton Road and Santa Fe Avenue in Flagstaff. Coming from the south, this is where Historic Route 66 headed northbound turns to the east. From the east, this is where Route 66 headed westbound turns to the south. Signs pointing to the Lowell Observatory are found both northbound on South Milton Road and westbound on Santa Fe Avenue.
- From the intersection, travel west on Santa Fe approximately 0.4 miles to the point where Santa Fe Avenue turns into West Mars Hill Road. The road makes a slight jog to the right as it turns into West Mars Hill Road and continues up the hill to the observatory.
- Continue approximately 0.6 miles to the Lowell Observatory.

Parking is located on your left as you arrive at the Lowell Observatory, on the south side of the Observatory grounds. Look for the orange and white orienteering signs.

August 27 - Fort Tuthill (Flagstaff)

The morning of the event started off with a huge thunderstorm at around 4:30am. We thought it might be over when arriving at the course at 7am and it was sunny. While hanging the beginner course it started to dump rain again.

The rain finally slowed down around 10am and we had an amazing 52 person turnout! The winner overall was Ron Birks who cleared the course with a time of 1:31! Others who also cleared the course in under the 2-hour time limit included Forest Brown, Erik Ringnes, and Andy Wentzel. The top team finishers were Team Slurm and Team Gold Cobra.

We'd like to thank everyone who helped with setup and tear down of the Tents and tables. A special thanks to Paul Kent for securing the location and inviting us to do a race at Fort Tuthill. We'd also like to thank Kevin Adams and Matt Zeilman for their work creating the map and scouting the course.
