# Dec. 9: Coon Bluff; Dec. 10, Saguaro Lake

A last-minute reminder of the events we have planned for this coming weekend. Pre-registration is not required for ANY of these events, but if you are planning to attend, pre-registration helps us know how many maps to print.

#### Sat Dec 9: Mesquite Library Clinic

From 9:00 - 10:30 am, we will present a beginner's clinic at the Mesquite Library (north side of Paradise Valley Mall). We provide instruction materials and we have some loaner compasses available (though if you have your own compass, bring that). There will be a practice course set up until noon. This clinic is FREE for everyone who attends.

### Sat Dec 9: Coon Bluff Night-O

Registration begins at 5 pm; there will be a mandatory pre-race briefing at 5:45 pm, and then the course will be open from 6 pm - 8 pm (with a mass start at 6 pm). A Night-O is like a Score-O - Controls are assigned different point values based on the distance they are located from the starting point and on the navigation difficulty. Participants are not required to follow a set course but instead try to maximize their point total through their own route choice. 10 points are deducted for each minute over time; DNF for finishing after 8:30 pm.

### Sun Dec 10: Saguaro Lake Score-O

Registration begins at 8:30 am; competitors may start the course any time from 9 am - 11 am, and everyone must be finished when the course closes at 1 pm. In this Score-O, you have two hours to find controls shown on a pre-printed map. Point values are based on distance and difficulty, and you can choose your own course. There will be a **Beginner's Clinic** at 9 am (no extra charge) and you'll still have time to do the Score-O when the Clinic is over.

### What to Bring:

- Whistle (Mandatory for all. Available for purchase at Phoenix events for \$1)
- Compass (Mandatory for all. Available for rent at Phoenix events for \$1)
- Water. There will be water at the start/finish.
- Sun screen.

Sturdy hiking shoes and long pants are recommended. You may encounter cactus, cat claw, and loose terrain.

For the Night-O event, bring lamps, batteries, spare batteries and even spare lamps. There will be some moonlight, but you'll want your own light!
